State and the opposite party no.2.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 504(C) of 2019 registered for the
offence punishable under section 498A of the Indian Penal
Code and section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner is ready to keep the complainant
with full honour and dignity and he is ready to pay Rs.
2500/- per month to the complainant for her maintenance. A
supplementary affidavit to that effect has been filed on
behalf of the petitioner, which is at Flag-S.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties and the undertaking given by the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in connection with Complaint Case No. 504C of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
