ORAL ORDER

3 21-09-2022 Mr. Kanishk Kaustubh, learned advocate appears on instruction from Mr. Ranjeet Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner.

This Court has been informed that during pendency of this writ application a charge-sheet has already been filed. It appears from the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is not satisfied with the investigation. Learned counsel, however on query submits that the petitioner has not



availed his remedy seeking further investigation in this case.

Mr. Deepak Kumar, learned AC to GP-4 is present for the State. It is submitted that so far as the present writ application is concerned, it has become infructuous.

This Court agrees with the submission of learned counsel for the State that the present writ application which was filed solely seeking a proper investigation of the case has become infructuous at this stage. If the petitioner is aggrieved by the investigation and is looking for further investigation or re-investigation of the case, he may seek his remedy as may be advised to him in accordance with law.

This application stands disposed of accordingly.
