This application has been filed by the petitioner for



restoration of Cr.W.J.C. No.1232 of 2019 which was dismissed for want of prosecution by this Court vide order dated 27.08.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that on 27.08.2019, the arguing counsel had met with an accident and has sustained fracture injury in his left leg. Thus, under the unavoidable and compelling circumstances, he could not attend the Court on that day as a result of which, the writ petition was dismissed for want of prosecution.

Learned counsel for the State does not oppose the prayer for restoration of Cr.W.J.C. No.1232 of 2019.
