Mr.Ravi Bhushan Verma, learned counsel for the Municipal Corporation, Begusarai has pointed out from Annexure-A to the show cause that in compliance of the order dated 17.01.2019 passed by this Court in CWJC No.3726 of 2018, the Municipal Commissioner, Begusarai has passed an order which in fact goes in favour of the petitioner.
