5 13-12-2022 Mr. Alok Ranjan, learned Advocate for the appellant, who has challenged the interim order passed by the learned Single Judge on 17.12.2019 in CWJC No. 15378 of 2019, submits that the writ petition has finally been disposed of.



He further submits that the aforementioned order was passed on 23.01.2020 and the final order passed by the Court in the writ petition has not yet been appealed against.

This appeal therefore loses its efficacy as no purpose would be served in challenging the interim order in a writ petition which has now been finally disposed of.
