Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That the Petitioner seeks the following reliefs through the present writ application:
- (i) To issue an appropriate writ/order/direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the Respondent 1 and 2 to pass an order for release 304 empty domestic gas cylinders belonging to respondent IOC ceased from possession of respondent no.5 while in transit through the truck of the petitioner.

(ii) To direct the respondent no. 4 to lay claim for release of 304 empty cylinders kept at the premises of respondent no. 6 as being custodian appointed by respondent no.2 due to which the petitioner has been fastened with liability of Rs. 1027, 989/- by creating debit note by respondent 4.

(iii) To direct respondent no. 4 to delete the debit note created against petitioner on account alleged non return of the said 304 cylinders due to illegal action of respondent no.2.

(iv) To grant any other relief(s) to which the petitioner may be found entitled to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition.

Permission is granted.

This petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
