The petitioners have filed the present application for restoration of Letters Patent Appeal No.1854 of 2012, which was dismissed for want of prosecution on 05.12.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that on 05.12.2019, when the case was called out, counsel for the petitioner could not reach the Court as a result of which it was dismissed for want of prosecution. He submitted that non-



appearance was neither deliberate nor willful rather it was due to compelling and unavoidable reasons.
