3 09-03-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“A. For a direction upon the respondents to conduct fresh bidding of the sandghats in the district of Jamui which was advertised for settlement through notice inviting tender;

B. For a declaration that the petitioner could not be deprived of participation in the tender process for reasons of technical glitches in the process of uploading of documents required for bidding in terms of the tender notice as it was onus of the



respondent department and it's authorities to facilitate smooth uploading of documents by intending bidders;

C. For further holding that maximum participation of intending bidders would be in the interest of public revenue and the respondent department ought to have considered the complain of the petitioner and made arrangements for inclusion of the petitioner in the tender process;

D. For grant of any other relief or reliefs to which the petitioner is entitled in the facts and circumstances of this case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that, in view of the intervening developments, the petition may be permitted to be withdrawn.

Prayer allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
