Petitioner seeks cancellation of bail granted by the Sessions Judge on December 18, 2021.

The grievance of the petitioner is largely directed against the conduct of the Public Prosecutor quo such person appearing for the accused in one case and for the prosecution in the other. It is also contended that there is a transfer petitioner pending.

The State and the private opposite parties are represented.

Affidavits filed in Court be taken on record.
