Upon hearing learned counsel, this Court deems it fit to direct the Joint Secretary, Technical Education, Training & Skill Development, Government of West Bengal to consider the representation made by the petitioners dated 6th December, 2021 for implementation of enhanced remuneration and other welfare schemes announced by the Government in respect of the contractual employees engaged with the different departments of the Government. The representation may be disposed of by a reasoned order upon hearing all concerned parties including the petitioners within two weeks from today. A copy of the reasoned order should be given to the petitioners within four days from the date on which such order is passed.

WPA 497 of 2022 is disposed of in terms of the order.

Since affidavits have not been called for, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted.
