Learned advocate for the State submits that the school has not forwarded all papers in respect of the petitioner to the concerned District Inspector of Schools.

I direct the Administrator and Teacher-in-Charge of the school, being the respondent nos. 7 and 8 to send all papers to the District Inspector of Schools within a period of one month from date of receipt of a

copy of this order and the concerned District Inspector of Schools is directed to take steps after receiving the papers including his right to call for a meeting of the petitioner and the school for clarification or any question within a period of three months thereafter and to take steps for payment of the arrear dues.

With this observation and direction, this writ application is disposed of.
