Petitioner seeks bail.

Considering the period of detention of the petitioner and considering the fact that the petitioner voluntarily deposited a pay order for the sum of Rs.50,000/-, drawn in favour of the de facto complainant with the police which the de facto complainant did not receive as appearing from the report of the police, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Serampore, subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall

be at liberty to cancel the bail of the petitioner in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail is allowed.

CRM (DB) 140 of 2022 is disposed of.
