Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were falsely implicated. They are the neighbors of the persons against whom the allegation was made.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the contents in the case diary including the statements recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code of the victim.

In the statements recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code of the victim, she named the principal accused as the person with whom she was in a relationship.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date and on further condition that the petitioner nos. 1, 2 , 5 and 6 shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a month till completion of investigation and petitioner nos. 3, 4 and 7 shall cooperate with the investigation.

Prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

CRM (A) 303 of 2022 is **disposed of**.
