Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the incident arose out of pre-existing property disputes.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the injury report of the victim.

Considering the nature of injury and the materials in the case diary and considering the fact that there is previous property dispute between the private parties, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/-each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the

petitioners shall meet the Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the investigation and that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. (A) 337 of 2022 is, thus, disposed of.
