The appellant is not represented nor any accommodation is prayed for on behalf of the appellant.

The report shows that the postal envelope sent to the addresses of the appellant (sole) and the respondent No.4 mentioned in the memo of appeal were returned unserved with the endorsement “Not Known” and “Deceased” in respect of respondent No.2.
