The application for anticipatory bail is taken up for consideration subsequent to the order dated March 30, 2022.

The victim lady recorded a statement under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) subsequent to the order dated March 30, 2022.

In her fresh 164 Cr.P.C. statement, the victim lady states that there is a relationship between the petitioner and the victim lady and that she married the petitioner as an adult.

Considering her 164 Cr.P.C. statement on April 8, 2022 and considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a month till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
