CRM (DB) 313 of 2022

In re : An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 31.01.2022 in connection with Hanskhali P.S. Case No. 652 of 2021 dated 16.09.2021 under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner seeks bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the victim proposed marriage with the daughter of the petitioner. Such marriage proposal was refused. Thereafter the victim committed suicide. He submits that the petitioner is in custody for 34 days. Another co-accused was granted anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the postmortem report and the contents in the case diary.

Considering the postmortem report and the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat, Nadia, subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until

further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of the petitioner in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail is allowed.

CRM (DB) 313 of 2022 is disposed of.
