The learned advocate appearing for the petitioner on previous occasion submits that the petitioner has taken no objection from him and he is not representing the petitioner at present.

None appears for the petitioner on repeated calls since the last date of listing.

The present case is for quashing of proceedings for offence punishable under section 3/4/5/6/7 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, the criminal revision stands dismissed for default. All connected applications stand disposed of.
