In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Kaliganj** P.S. Case No.**56 of 2022** dated **25/01/2022** under Sections **447/376/506** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that previously a similar complaint was lodged against the petitioner. The petitioner was falsely implicated.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the statement recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of the victim.

Considering the age of the victim and considering her statement recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure where the victim claims that there was a love relationship between her and the petitioner, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of

Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the investigation and that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. (A) 605 of 2022 is, thus, disposed of.
