despite complaint to the Officer-in-charge,  
Swarupnagar Police Station and the Superintendent of  
Police, Basirhat, North 24 Parganas, no steps have

Station has filed report in the form of instructions  
addressed to the Government Pleader, High Court,  
Calcutta and the same is taken on record.
