Ms. Sinha submits on instructions that the West Bengal State Election Commission is yet to receive the accounts of the petitioner. Such accounts form a part of the writ petition.

It is assured by Ms. Sinha that once the accounts are filed the notification removing the order of disqualification of the petitioner, shall be issued immediately as has been done in case of other similarly situated persons.

This writ petition is disposed of.

There will be however no order as to costs.
