Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were falsely implicated.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the materials in the case diary.

Considering the fact that petitioners are not named in the First Information Report and are sought to be proceeded against on the basis of the statements of the co-accused made while in custody and considering the involvement of the petitioners in the incident, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the

arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date and on further condition that the petitioners shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till completion of investigation.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is **allowed.**
