The petitioner by filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has prayed for expeditious disposal of the application filed under Order XIV Rule 2(2) read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure in connection with Title Suit No. 79 of 2019, pending before the learned 6th Bench, City Civil Court, Calcutta.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the learned Court below has been granting

unnecessary adjournments and due to which, there is a delay in disposal of the case and such delay is causing hardship to the petitioner.

Having regard to the nature of relief claimed by the petitioner, being a prayer for expeditious disposal of interlocutory application, it is not likely to cause any prejudice to the interest of the opposite party.
