Mr. Debjit Mukherjee, learned advocate appears for the petitioner.

Record shows that the notice of this application has not been served on the opposite parties.

The petitioner by filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has prayed for expeditious disposal of ARC Case No. 147/08 (ARC Case No. 147/17/08), pending before the learned Additional Rent Controller, Kolkata.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the learned Court below has been granting unnecessary adjournments and due to which, there is a delay in disposal of the case and such delay is causing hardship to the petitioner.

Having regard to the nature of relief claimed by the petitioner, being a prayer for expeditious disposal of the ARC Case No. 147/08 (ARC Case No. 147/17/08), I do not find any need to serve notice of the present application on the opposite parties and it is not likely to cause any prejudice to the interest of the opposite
