The writ petitioner is aggrieved by the conduct of the Axis Bank in insisting on pre-payment charges for closing a loan account and also ignoring the terms of the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme.

The petitioner has approached the Banking Ombudsman, who has rejected his claim by communication dated March 8, 2022.

The petitioner grievances cannot be addressed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India since there is little or no public element attached to the relations between the parties. There are disputed questions of facts that are required to be gone into. The petitioner's remedy is before an appropriate civil or other statutory

forum with reserving liberty to approach the said forum by the petitioner.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
