Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that the police filed charge-sheet and considering the fact that the husband is in custody and considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date and on further conditions the petitioners shall appear before the court below on every date fixed for hearing.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the

petitioners is allowed.

CRM (A) 1002 of 2022 is, thus, disposed of.
