The officer-in-charge, Baruipur Police Station, shall ensure that there is no breach of peace, intimidation or threat in any manner whatsoever, to any candidates in the forthcoming municipal election.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
