**In Re: WPA No.3498 of 2022**

The grievance of the petitioner is that, despite  
having given a representation to the Assistant

Registrar, Co-operative Societies on January 15, 2019 regarding several complaints made by the petitioner, the Assistant Registrar, that is, the respondent no.4, has not taken any steps in that regard.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.4, in his usual fairness, submits that although the representation dated January 15, 2019 (Annexure-P4 at page-20 of the writ petition) is not in the form of a dispute case, the Assistant Registrar is willing to take steps for inquiry subject to the order of this court.

Since certain serious allegations have been levelled in his complaints by the writ petitioner, it would be desirable that the Assistant Registrar inquires into the matter in accordance with law at the earliest.

Accordingly, WPA No.3498 of 2022 is disposed of, without any order as to costs, by directing the respondent no.4 to initiate and conduct an inquiry within the contemplation of Section 100 of the Co-operatives Societies Act, 2006 on the basis of the representation, being Annexure-P4 at page-20 of the present writ petition and to dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months from date, and to take appropriate steps accordingly.
