The police authorities have submitted a report and the same is taken on record. The police report indicates that pursuant to the complaint filed by the petitioner, Behala Police Station Case No.105 dated April 15, 2022 under Section 341/323/505 of the Indian Penal Code against Smt. Suchitra Mitra, the respondent No.8, has been registered and the investigation is under progress.

According to the police authorities, there is a long standing dispute between the petitioner and the daughter-in-law. However, as the police authorities have already initiated an investigation, the same shall be concluded in a free and fair
