CRM 1824 of 2021

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Arambagh** P.S. case No. **419 of 2020** dated **16/11/2020** under Sections **186/332/333/353/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Sections 3 and 4 of P.D.P.P. Act, 1984 and Section 9 of the West Bengal Maintenance of Public Order Act, 1972.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that the police filed charge-sheet and considering the fact that the other co-accuseds were granted bail by jurisdictional Court, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner

is allowed.

CRM 1824 of 2021 is, thus disposed of.
