Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the husband and the de facto complainant are both Border Security Force personnel. Both of them were posted in Jammu. He submits that the petitioners were falsely implicated.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the injury report of the de facto complainant.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein and considering the injury report of the de facto complainant, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer

and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner nos.1, 3 and 5 shall meet the Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner nos.2 and 4 will cooperate with the investigation and that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 1113 of 2022 is disposed of.
