**C.R.M. (DB) 707 of 2022**

In Re: - An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on **09.03.2022** in connection with **Thanarpara** P.S. Case No. **203** of **2021** dated **22.11.2021** under Section **148/149/323/302/504** of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections **25/27** of the Arms Act and under Sections **3/4** of the Explosive Substances Act.

Petitioner seeks bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 111 days. The police filed charge-sheet and, therefore, further detention of the petitioner is not required.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the statements of the eyewitnesses recorded under Section 161 of the Criminal Procedure Code as also to the statement recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein as transpiring from the statement of the eyewitnesses recorded under Section 161 of the Criminal Procedure Code, we are unable to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

**C.R.M. (DB) 707 of 2022** is dismissed.
