A direction to secure expeditious disposal of Title Suit No. 69 of 2008, pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court, Barasat, is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

The only contention expressed by the petitioner is against the delay caused in the disposal of the suits.

No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of the order proposed to be made in the case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite parties is thus dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court, Barasat is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of suit, in connection with Title Suit No. 69 of 2008, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this case, but

without granting unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of this order to the learned court below as well as to the learned advocate appearing in the court below for the opposite parties and the opposite parties.

With this observation and direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
