This petition has been filed questioning the order dated 03.03.2022 issued by the State authorities 9down the internet services in certain areas of some of the districts on the ground of preventing the cheating in Madhyamik Examination.

Another petition being WPA 104 of 2022 was filed at that stage which came up for consideration and this Court had passed the interim order dated 10.03.2022, as a result of which the order dated 03.03.2022 was not given effect.

Learned Advocate General has informed that meanwhile the examinations are over.

In the aforesaid circumstances, we are of the view that nothing survives in this petition. In case, if the State

authorities issue any similar order in future, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach this Court.

The petition is accordingly dismissed as infructuous on the aforesaid observations.
