Mr. Arjun Roy Mukherjee, learned counsel,

preliminary objection with regard to the jurisdiction of
this Hon'ble Court to entertain the writ petition. He
refers to Section 14(2) of the Administrative Tribunals
Act, 1985 along with a notification dated 31st March,
2010 to contend that Steel Authority of India is a
body that falls under the Administrative Tribunals
Act, 1985. Therefore, the writ petition is not

WPA 4646 of 2022, is dismissed.
