C.R.M. (A) 1319 of 2022

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on **15.03.2022** in connection with **English Bazar** P.S. Case No. **399** of **2020** dated **11.05.2020** under Section **27(A)** of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the police filed charge-sheet and, therefore, further detention of the petitioner is not required.

None appears for the State even in the second call. The case diary is not produced on behalf of the State.

Considering such conduct of the State and considering the fact that the police filed charge-sheet, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Consequently, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 1319 of 2022 is, thus disposed of.
