C.R.M. (A) 1377 of 2022

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on **21.03.2022** in connection with **Minakhan** P. S. Case No. **291** of **2021** dated **08.10.2021** under Sections **498A/302/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a resident of a different locality. He refers to the statement made in the First Information Report. He submits that the husband of the deceased was granted bail by the Sessions Court. The petitioner was falsely implicated.

Learned advocate appearing for the State submits that the death was by smothering, homicidal in nature. There are statements recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code implicating the petitioner.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein as transpiring from the materials in the case diary, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.

C.R.M. (A) 1377 of 2022 is, thus, dismissed.
