From the order dated 07.01.2022 passed by the
learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Additional Court,
Sealdah, South 24 Parganas in Ejectment Execution
Case No. 43 of 2019, it appears that the said execution
case has been disposed of on full and final satisfaction
in view of the fact that the bailiff of the Court had
delivered possession of the decreetal property to the
decree-holder.

Therefore, in view of such facts, this Court is of
the opinion that the petitioners are no more interested
to proceed with the instant application as the same has
become infructuous and as such, they are not
