It is submitted by the learned Advocate for the petitioner that the instant contempt application has virtually become infructuous in view of the fact that mop up round has also been completed. In fact, the alleged contemnor has submitted a report pertaining to an assessment of the appellant in terms of the order dated March 16, 2022. We further find therefrom that she was further asked for a test for specific learning disorder on March 21, 2022 but thereafter she did not turn up and, therefore, the testing could not be carried out.
