In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Howrah** P.S. case No. **524 of 2018** dated **26/09/2018** under Sections **186/189/283/353/332/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 9/15A of the West Bengal Maintenance of Public Order Act, 1972.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that the police filed charge-sheet and considering the fact that the petitioners are ladies, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

CRM 2364 of 2021 is, thus disposed of.
