Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and that the appellant seeks to withdraw the appeal and go before the concerned authority, we delete that portion of the order passed by the learned Single Bench imposing costs on the appellant.

Accordingly, the appeal along with the connected application are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the appellant to approach the concerned

authority in accordance with law. However, the imposition of costs stands deleted.
