Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that there was a property dispute between the private parties which lead to the incident.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention to the postmortem report of the victim, the contents of the first information report and the statement of the eye witnesses recorded under Section 161 and 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

There are materials in the case diary squarely implicating the petitioners in the incident of murder. Consequently, we are unable to grant bail to the petitioners at this stage.
