Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not involved in the crime. The account was being operated by the brother of the petitioner with the petitioner not having control over the same. Another co-accused was enlarged on bail by the jurisdictional Court.

Learned advocate appearing for the State submits that the co-accused who was granted bail by the jurisdictional Court was so enlarged on statutory bail. Such co-accused was in a relationship with the de facto complainant and such co-accused misused his relationship with the de facto complainant and forged the signature of the de facto complainant to issue cheque, which was encashed in the account belonging to the petitioner.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner as transpiring from the materials in the case diary, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.

CRM (A) 1651 of 2022 is **dismissed**.
