CRM (DB) 976 of 2022

In re : An Application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 07.04.2022 in connection with Kaliganj P.S. Case No. 28 of 2022 dated 12.01.2022 under Sections 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and added Section 304B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioner prays for bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 83 days. The police filed charge-sheet and further detention of the petitioner is not required.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention to the statement of the husband of the victim recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and to the injury report of the victim.

The doctor recording the injuries of the victim, notes that the victim claimed that she caught fire in front of the petitioner and that the petitioner locked the door.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein as transpiring from the materials in the case diary, we are unable to grant bail to the petitioner.

CRM (DB) 976 of 2022 is rejected
