In terms of the order dated 22nd June, 2022, the respondents have informed the petitioner that the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Kolkata Bench, will sit on 21st July, 2022 and 22nd July, 2022. The petitioner has also filed an original application before the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Kolkata Bench, being Diary No. 1073/74 dated 8th July, 2022.

Nothing further remains to be adjudicated in this writ petition. The same is disposed of accordingly without any order as to costs.

Since I have not called for any affidavits, allegation made in the writ petition are deemed to have not been admitted by the respondents.
