**C.R.M. (A) 1759 of 2022**

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Gopalnagar** Police Station Case No. **154** of **2022** dated **03.04.2022** under Sections **498A/306/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the husband is in custody. No overt act can be attributed to any of the petitioners in the incident. The victim committed suicide.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the Post Mortem Report of the victim.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein as transpiring from the materials in the case diary and considering the fact that the husband is in custody, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner nos. 1, 2 and 3 will report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and the petitioner no. 4 will co-operate with the Investigation and on

condition that the petitioners shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

**C.R.M. (A) 1759 of 2022** is, thus, disposed of.
