This revisional application has been filed by the petitioner under Section 401 of the Code of Criminal Procedure challenging the order dated 31.01.2011 passed by Learned Judicial Magistrate, Jhargram, District – Paschim Medinipur in M.R. Case No.99 of 2007 whereby maintenance was allowed to the petitioner and her minor daughter of Rs.500/- and Rs.1,500/- per month respectively.
