CRM(A) 1841 of 2022

In re: An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Jangipara Police Station Case No.34 of 2022 dated 27.02.2022 under Sections 341/ 323/ 325/ 326/ 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

Considering the gravity of the offence and involvement of the petitioners therein as it transpires from the Case Diary and the statement of the injured recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner nos.1, 3 and 4 will report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner no.2 will cooperate with the investigation till its completion and on further condition that the petitioners will

appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

CRM(A) 1841 of 2022 is disposed of.
