CRM(A) 1845 of 2022

In re: An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Kalna Police Station Case No.868 of 2021 under Sections 341/ 324/ 326/ 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Considering the nature of the injury suffered by the victim and considering the gravity of the offence and involvement of the petitioners therein as it transpires from the Case Diary, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will

pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.
