**C.R.M. (DB) 1122 of 2022**

In Re: - An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Kaliachak** P.S. Case No.**886 of 2020** dated **10/11/2020** under Sections **498A/323/307/34** of the Indian Penal Code and Sections **3** and **4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act. (G.R. No.5113 /2020).

Petitioner seeks bail.

Considering the period of detention of the petitioner, that is, 35 days and considering the fact that the police submitted charge sheet and considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein, we grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Malda, subject to the condition that during bail the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing and that the petitioner shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without any further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

The application for bail being **C.R.M. (DB) 1122 of 2022** is,
